

#### SUGGESTED WEEKLY ROUTINE FOR REMOTE LEARNING

## 3<sup>rd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade English Language Arts

## Monday:

- Provide students with the chapter or text for the week.
- Have students read the text. If it's a longer text have students read part of the text.
- Students write down two to three interesting facts they learned while reading.

## Tuesday:

- Have students reread the text for fluency. If it's a longer text, have students finish reading the text.
- Students write three to four sentences (Grade 3) or a paragraph (Grades 4-5) to answer a key question.

#### Wednesday:

- Teacher runs a virtual group conversation (via Zoom, Google Hangout, etc.) to talk about the text, or,
- Students submit a video of themselves talking about the text (via ClassDojo, SeeSaw, etc.), either answering a teacher-chosen question or describing their favorite character.

# Thursday:

- Independent study: students choose to study something related to the text.
  - Ways for students to learn more include:
    - Find e-books online that are about the same topic. Books can be checked out as <u>e-books from students' local libraries</u>, or through sites like <u>Epic!</u>.
    - Find articles about the topic. Potential websites for students to explore include: <a href="www.newsela.com">www.newsela.com</a>, <a href="www.scholastic.com">www.scholastic.com</a>, or <a href="www.readinga-z.com">www.readinga-z.com</a>.
    - Check out the virtual experiences being offered by local and national museums.
    - Look for videos on YouTube.
    - Conduct interviews of people in their lives.

# Friday:

- Independent study: students continue to study and research something related to the text.
- Students share what they learned with their teacher or with the class.
