

#### SUGGESTED WEEKLY ROUTINE FOR REMOTE LEARNING

### K-2<sup>nd</sup> Grade English Language Arts

### Monday:

- Students watch the read aloud.
- Students (K-1) draw a picture or (K-2) write a sentence answering a teacher-chosen question.

## Tuesday:

- Students watch the read aloud again.
- Students (K) draw a picture, (1-2) write a few sentences answering a teacher-chosen question, or (K-2) use a word map to diagram a vocabulary word.

### Wednesday:

- Teacher runs a remote group conversation (via Zoom, Google Hangout, etc.) to talk about the text, or
- Students submit a video of themselves talking about the text (via ClassDojo, SeeSaw, etc.) either answering a teacher-chosen question or describing their favorite character.

# Thursday:

- Independent study: students choose to study something related to the text.
  - Ways for students to learn more include:
    - Find e-books online that are about the same topic. Books can be checked out as <u>e-books from students' local libraries</u>, or through sites like <u>Epic!</u>.
    - Find articles about the topic. Potential websites for students to explore include: <a href="https://www.newsela.com">www.newsela.com</a>, <a href="https://www.scholastic.com">www.scholastic.com</a>, or <a href="https://www.readinga-z.com">www.readinga-z.com</a>.
    - Check out the virtual experiences being offered by local and national museums.
    - Look for videos on YouTube.

### Friday:

- Independent study: students continue to study and research something related to the text.
- Students share what they learned with their teacher or with the class.
